Police questioning

The law about police questioning has not been affected by the *Law Enforcement (Powers and Responsibilities) Act 2002* (“LEPRA”), except that the rights of suspects under arrest at the police station are now covered by Part 9 of LEPRA (formerly Part 10A of the *Crimes Act*). The special rights for vulnerable people are now covered by LEPRA section 112 (formerly *Crimes Act* section 356A).
